

SAFE DISPOSAL, STORAGE, AND USE OF YOUR OPIOID PAIN MEDICINE

DISPOSE OF UNUSED OPIOID PAIN MEDICATIONS

It is important to dispose of unused opioid pain medications because prescription opioid misuse is common in the United States. Many people aged 12 or older who misused opioid pain medications bought, stole, or were given the drug from a friend or relative.



The pre-paid drug mail-back envelope helps you securely dispose of unused opioid medications.

- ✓ Drugs will not be left in your home or community, reducing the risk of misuse and overdose.
- ✓ Your leftover medication will be securely transported for destruction.

To use the pre-paid drug mail-back envelope, follow the user instructions

STORE OPIOIDS TO KEEP FRIENDS AND FAMILY SAFE

Store your opioid medication securely, out of sight and reach of children, and in a location not accessible by others, including visitors to the home. Never share or give anyone else your opioid medication.

USE YOUR PRESCRIPTION SAFELY

Take your opioid medicine exactly as prescribed. Follow the Medication Guide that came with your medicine and the guidance your pharmacist provided.
